- 1953** Chew, Harvey & Thomas is founded. The company later gains recognition in the agency world as Ted Thomas Associates.
- 1963** A health care marketing communications company begins to take shape when Johnson & Johnson signs on with Ted Thomas to launch several hospital products. This leads to consumer health education initiatives for baby and personal product lines.
- 1985** Ted Thomas Associates forms CoMed Communications to specialize in educational programs for health care professionals.
- 1986** The Institute for Continuing Healthcare Education—an independent, accredited education company—is created.
- 1997** The company restructures under the Vox Medica, Inc. name.
- 1999** Signova is founded as Vox Medica's full-service health care public relations offering.
- 2002** Vox Medica, Inc. is ranked as the largest independent communications company in Philadelphia.
- 2003** Vox Medica, Inc. celebrates 50 years of independence.
- 2009** Owned by the four principals, Vox Medica Holdings, Inc. includes the promotional health care entity of Vox Medica (Vox) and the Institute for Continuing Healthcare Education (the Institute).
